DASH for Detection 5K Run/Walk Returns to Montrose Harbor on June 11 *Online Registration In-Person and Virtual Event is Open*

CHICAGO, May 26th, 2022 – Rolfe Pancreatic Cancer Foundation’s DASH for Detection 5K Run/Walk returns to Chicago’s Montrose Harbor on Saturday, June 11.

Now in its 12th year, Rolfe and partner organization, Lustgarten Foundation, will welcome more than 1,600 supporters to celebrate patients and survivors, and honor loved ones gone too soon. All proceeds goes toward Rolfe’s mission to provide personal support to those affected by pancreatic cancer through tailored resources, connections and education, and funding for early detection research.

“We’re thrilled to be back,” said Stacia Hart, Rolfe’s Executive Director. “Our community has always been a strong force behind everything we do. To once again join together—in person—to support Rolfe’s efforts will only strengthen our presence and our ability to help so many families in need.”

This 5K Run/Walk on Chicago’s lakefront features special guest speakers and festivities for the whole family. Montrose Harbor’s vast open-air location will provide a safe environment for all participants. In addition, all city, state and CDC recommended guidelines will be in place, including sanitizer stations.

“Over the past two years during COVID, our community came together virtually with DASHing Together with participants from around the world joining in,” explained Rolfe Board President, Rachel Sheinkop. “That’s why we’re excited to once again offer a virtual option—DASH at a Distance for those who can’t make it to Chicago or aren’t quite ready to gather.”

DASH at a Distance will take place throughout the month of June, providing an additional option for the Rolfe community to raise awareness around the world.

“We pride ourselves on getting to know our patients and their families by being at the frontlines and making the calls to the doctors and hospitals to expedite the referral process,” shared Stacia. “Donations we receive from DASH and throughout the year helps us provide this personal and tailored approach, so we can be there for continued support and guidance.”
